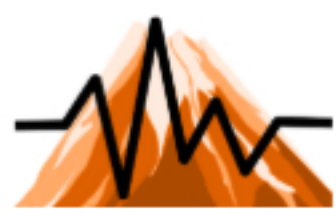

Eruption

Minor Strombolian activity and lava effusion; Lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.2 km), and Mi-isi (2.1 km) gullies



Seismicity

8 volcanic earthquakes; 120 Rockfall and 3 pyroclastic density current signals



Crater glow

Fair (naked eye)

SO₂



Sulfur

Dioxide Flux

912 tonnes / day (20 July 2026)



Plume

Weak emission; general west drift



Ground

Deformation

Inflation of the edifice with short-term deflation on the northeastern sector



Earthquake Location: ● Past 24 hours ● Past 2 weeks

Total no. of volcanic earthquake: 8 Total no. w/ enough record for location: 5

RECOMMENDATION/COMMENT



Should not be allowed

- Entry into 6-kilometer radius Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ)
- Flying any aircraft close to the volcano



Reminder

Possible hazards that can occur:

- Rockfalls or landslides or avalanches
- Ballistic fragments
- Lava flows and lava fountaining
- Pyroclastic density currents
- Moderate-sized explosions
- Lahars during heavy and prolonged rainfall
